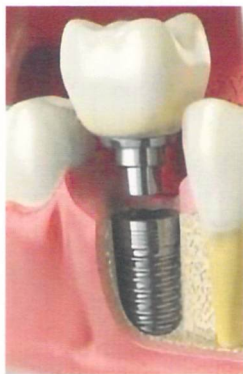


Benefits of Dental Implants
